They will share their dowsing secrets for shifting awareness and enhancing travel, to return with gifts of wonder and joy. The talk includes *The Power of Place*, a multimedia show created from their pilgrimage journeys.

Cindy Pavlinac is a fine art photographer, multimedia artist, writer, and violist. She works on location in Europe and North America photographing ancient sanctuaries and modern expressions of the sacred. Her images have appeared in numerous publications, including *Time Magazine's Pictures of the Year* and the books *Labyrinths* and *Sanctuaries of the Goddess*, plus Grace Cathedral and Veriditas websites.
